

<p>Year 1</p>  <p>Autumn Term</p>		<p>In Writing this term the children will be supported to develop the ability to; consistently apply their phonics knowledge to support their spelling, develop the use of finger spaces between words, compose a sentence orally before writing it and form their letters correctly. Children will learn to recognise and compose capital letters.</p>
<p>Interested in what your child will be learning this term?</p> <p>We have put together some information explaining exactly what your children will be learning.</p> <p>Please send us a message via Class Dojo with any questions you have in relation to their learning.</p>  <p>Year 1 Team</p>		<p>In Mathematics this term we will be covering the following topics; place value, addition, subtraction and shape including finding patterns. The children will spend time mastering key skills in order to support their developing retrieval of number facts and to enable them to reason and problem solve mathematically.</p>
		<p>In Music this term we will be focusing on performing. The children will be learning to; make and control long and short sounds, using voice and instruments. Learn and perform chants, rhythms, raps and songs. Follow instructions on how and when to sing or play an instrument. Work and perform together with others.</p>
		<p>In Art and Design & Technology this term the children will explore a wide variety of things. In art they will learn to draw lines of different sizes, as well as use a variety of tools (such as pens, pencils and chalk) to represent objects in lines. In D&T they will take inspiration from design throughout history to support their ability to design, make, evaluate and improve.</p>
		<p>In Geography and History this term the children will; study the geography of the school and the land use around the school, as well as devising a simple map. In history the children will be given the opportunity to investigate and interpret the past. We will be focusing on The Gun Powder Plot and through this learning the children will learn how to communicate historically.</p>
		<p>In Science this term the children will observe and discuss the seasonal changes they notice as summer turns to autumn and then again from autumn to winter. Our learning on materials will require the children to name and identify a variety of every day materials, as well as distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. The children will partake in experiments to enable them to apply their newly acquired knowledge.</p>
		<p>In R.E this term the children will develop their understanding of the different beliefs and teachings within Christianity, Islam and Buddhism. We will be looking at special places and why they are significant within these religions.</p>
		<p>In P.E this term the children will be working with 'SCS' in order to develop a wide range of skills. They will master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.</p>
		<p>In Computing this term, the children will learn key skills such as how to use the basic parts of a device. They will also learn that we control computers by giving instructions in order and learn about what an algorithm is, in order to create a simple algorithm to control a floor robot.</p>
